




- I. AUTHORITY: Bureau of Correctional Healthcare Services
- II. PURPOSE: Kitchen, dining and food storage areas are kept clean and sanitary for the preparation and serving of meals; food handling uses proper hygienic practices.
- III. APPLICABILITY: All Department of Correction employees and vendor staff, offenders, and any outside healthcare provider servicing DOC offenders.
- IV. DEFINITIONS: See glossary.
- V. POLICY:
  1. The site Health Service Administrator (HSA) or designee will review inspections of the Dietary Department and assist in problem-solving activities as requested.
  2. The site HSA will encourage and support dietary inspections by outside agencies such as the Public Health Department.
  3. The site HSA or designee will participate in dietary inspections as requested.
  4. The site HSA will report findings, which might endanger health of offenders or staff, and make recommendations for corrective action in writing, to the Dietary Supervisor.
  5. Offender food service workers will be medically screened according to the requirements of the Department of Health and Social Services by Health Services prior to assignment.
