- I. AUTHORITY:** 11 *Del. C.* §6501, § 6502, § 6503, § 6504, 29 *Del. C.* §8901, § 8903
- II. PURPOSE:** To establish the process of issuing each inmate released from a Level V or Level IV institution or program an Inmate Identification Card.
- III. APPLICABILITY:** All Department of Correction (DOC) employees involved in the release process of inmates from Level V or Level IV institutions or programs.
- IV. DEFINITIONS:** None
- IV. POLICY:** In order to help facilitate offender reentry, every offender released to the street from a Level V or Level IV institution or program will be issued an offender I.D. through the appropriate the Delaware Automated Correctional System (DACS) program. As outlined in DOC Reentry policy 3.12 sentenced offenders are encouraged to voluntarily participate in the Department's Reentry program, IADAPT (Individual Assessment, Discharge and Planning Team), which may facilitate a Department of Motor Vehicle Identification Card or driver's license.
