Five Offenders Leave Grounds of Plummer Community Corrections Center

A group of five offenders serving violation of probation sentences at the Plummer Community Corrections Center in Wilmington left facility grounds without authorization Friday night. Department of Correction (DOC) Emergency Response Teams, as well as Wilmington Police and Delaware State Police, launched an immediate search to bring the men back in to custody.

The five offenders, all black males, are:

- Jermaine Miller, 30, 5'10" and 160 pounds
- Markeevs McDougal, 25, 5'06" and 175 pounds
- Irvin Lewis, 31, 5'03" and 180 pounds
- Andrew Burgos, 18, 5'09" and 160 pounds
- Kiayre Braxton, 21, 5'07" and 140 pounds

Duty Officers were informed of a group of offenders leaving the grounds around 9:20 p.m. An emergency head count confirmed that five residents were unaccounted for and the law enforcement notification was made.

Plummer Community Corrections Center is a Level 4 facility where the DOC manages offenders who are transitioning back into the community. These centers are not secured like Level 5 prisons, as offenders are permitted to leave the facility to go to work, seek jobs or attend approved treatment sessions.

DOC officials continue to investigate the situation.
