Two Offenders Leave Plummer Community Corrections Center

Two offenders serving sentences at the Plummer Community Corrections Center (PCCC) in Wilmington left the facility grounds without authorization Sunday night.

Staff members were informed that David N. Succarote and Brandon Z. Williams were seen jumping over the facility's perimeter wall around 6:00 p.m. An emergency headcount confirmed the two men were not on grounds.

Succarote is a 24-year-old white male who is 5'09" and weighs 150 pounds. He has blue eyes and brown hair, with scars on his chest and left knee. He was serving an eight-month sentence for Robbery 1st. He arrived at PCCC on October 10, 2011. His last known address is in Wilmington.

Williams is a 21-year-old white male who is 5'08" and weighs 140 pounds. He has brown eyes and strawberry blonde hair, with tattoos on his left hand, left arm, right hand and right arm. He was serving a six-month sentence for violation of probation on an original charge of Burglary 2nd. He arrived at PCCC on September 14, 2011. His last known address is in New Castle.

Officers continue their search for both men and request that anyone with information call (800) 542-9524 or their local police department.

Plummer Community Corrections Center is a Level 4 facility where the Department of Correction manages offenders who are transitioning back into the community. These centers are not secured like Level 5 prisons, as offenders are permitted to leave the facility to go to work, seek jobs or attend approved treatment sessions.
