Offender Escapes from Plummer Community Corrections Center

An offender serving a sentence at the Plummer Community Corrections Center (PCCC) in Wilmington left the facility grounds without authorization on Monday, September 3.

Janiis Mathis was observed leaving the facility by climbing over a perimeter fence around 9:45 p.m.

Mathis is a 20-year-old black male (DOB 04/22/1992) who is 5'06" and weighs 130 pounds. He has brown eyes, black hair, a mustache with a goatee, and a tattoo on his right finger. Mathis was last seen wearing a black shirt and gray pants. His last known address is in Wilmington.

Mathis arrived at PCCC on August 22 to serve a 90-day sentence for a Violation of Probation on an original charge of Possession within 1,000 Feet of a School.

Officers continue their search for Mathis and request that anyone with information call (800) 542-9524 or their local police department.

Plummer Community Corrections Center is a Level 4 facility where the Department of Correction manages offenders who are transitioning back into the community. These centers are not secured like Level 5 prisons, as offenders are permitted to leave the facility to go to work, seek jobs or attend approved treatment sessions.
