It is the law of the State of Delaware and the policy in the Department of Correction that no person shall be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefit of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination on the grounds of race, color, sex, age or national origin. This policy also certifies full compliance with Title VI, Civil Rights Act of 1964.

No officer, facility or employee of the Department of Correction shall practice or tolerate the existence of such discriminatory practices with regard to any aspect of employment, treatment of employees, services rendered, or facilities supported.
