

## Inmate Visitation Procedures Updated August 26, 2022

Please note: Visits must be scheduled in advance directly through the facility.

## YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO enter any DOC facility at any time if you:

• have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 10 days

- have had any symptoms of COVID-19/flu-like illness within the past 10 days, including fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste, loss of smell, or other flulike symptoms
- have been exposed to someone with a known diagnosis of COVID-19 within the past 10 days

## **Visitation Ground Rules:**

- Through September 5, 2022 visits are restricted to one (1) adult visitor (18 years of age or older) per inmate per visit. <a href="PLEASE NOTE: Beginning September 6">PLEASE NOTE: Beginning September 6</a>, 2022 one (1) adult visitor and one (1) child visitor (under 18 years of age) will be permitted per inmate per visit.
- All visitors are encouraged to wear a DOC-issued face mask at all times while in a correctional facility. Face masks will be made available to visitors upon arrival. Visitors should leave their personal face masks inside their vehicle in the parking area before approaching the facility entrance.
- All visitors may be screened when entering the facility. The screening may include a
  series of questions about their medical condition and whether they have had any
  direct or indirect contact with someone who has been tested for COVID-19 or is in
  quarantine. Visitors who have a temperature of 100 degrees or higher, have
  other symptoms of COVID-19, or have had close contact with someone with COVID19 or is in quarantine will be directed to leave the facility.
- All visitors may be required to fully complete and sign a disclaimer form before the
  visit begins stating that they have not tested positive for COVID-19, have no
  symptoms of COVID-19, and have had no direct or indirect contact with someone
  who has been tested for COVID-19 or is in quarantine. NOTE: The disclaimer also
  authorizes DOC to take steps to independently verify this information.
